Class 6 will also be concentrating on the grammar requirements needed to create more complex sentences and stories.

Maths:

Using the Red Rose Maths scheme for Year 6, the children will look at the following units:

Multiplication

Science: Life cycles and reproduction.

Describe the life cycle of a plant, including the reproductive stage.

Describe the life cycle of a mammal.

Describe the life cycle of a bird and compare it with that of a mammal.

Describe the life cycle of an amphibian.

Describe the life cycle of an insect and compare it with that of an amphibian.

Describe asexual reproduction in plants.

RE: Creation and covenant.

The children will be looking at the creation of man and woman and the subsequent fall and first sin. They will have an understanding of the Christian belief that, in Jesus, a new covenant is made and through him, the relationship with God can be restored.

Geography:

Would you like to live in the desert?

Lines of latitude, physical and human features of a desert, recognise Mojave Desert has a different time zone to UK. Threats to deserts. Compare two biomes.

History: Will be taught in Autumn 2

Invasion/ Team games – Apply sports specific skills with control and precision – including different types of passes, kicking, shooting and catching. Work as a team to defend and attack in 4V4 and 5V5 invasion games.
